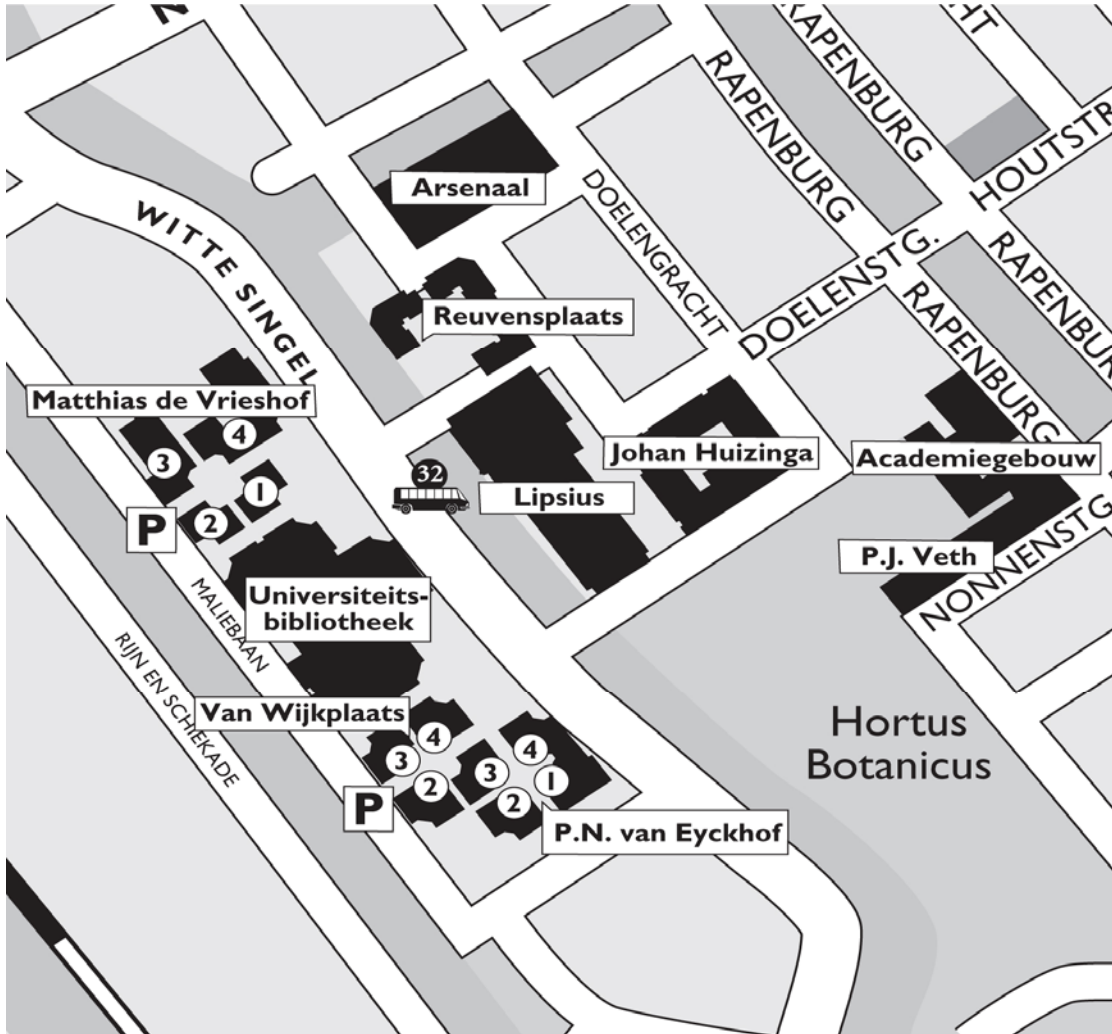


## Map Faculties of Humanities and Archaeology
